



As pioneers in the Washington State wine industry, Gail and Shirley Puryear planted their first grapes in 1980. From that original half-acre, they now have 29 acres surrounding the winery. In 2002 they purchased the Morrison Vineyard on North Bonair Road which boasts “old vine Cabernet Sauvignon” planted in 1968. Total acreage is now 35 acres.

Gail and Shirley manage the winery with the help of a full-time winemaker and tasting room manager. They have a vineyard foreman who oversees all operations in the vineyard. Having total control from vine to bottle ensures a consistently high quality product.

We have a state-of-the-art production facility including a separate barrel building with controlled temperature and humidity. Three hundred French and American oak barrels are used to find the perfect blend for our reserve Rattlesnake Hills wine. The bottles are filled, corked, foiled, and labeled using the latest technology to assure consistent quality. We specialize in buttery Chardonnay, Bordeaux-style reds such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec, and Cabernet Franc. We also produce sweeter wines like Riesling and Port-style wines.

We invite you to enjoy our European-style tasting room and grounds with bistro tables and a picnic area. Enjoy a glass of wine by the duck pond and walk thru the vineyard on the way to the tasting room. Come and let us share with you our passion for wine and life!~
