



Masset Winery, founded in 1999 by **Greg and Michaela Masset**, is one of only a handful of wineries owned and operated by a Certified Chef. Accordingly, our goal is to create wines that will complement dinner. We see oak, tannins, and acidity as spices that must be in balance. Just as too much salt would ruin a meal, no single component of the wine should be overdone. With wine, as in life, balance is key. We use grapes grown in highly regarded hillside locations and conduct our own barrel tests to find the best matches. Fermenting in small lots and keeping individual barrels of wine separate until the final blending is expensive and labor-intensive, but we consider it essential.

In the summer of 2003, we moved the winery to a 1905 farmstead in the **Parker Heights** area of **Wapato** and immediately embarked on an extensive restoration. The first of our projects, a beautifully crafted old barn complete with cupola, houses the Tasting Room on the main floor and provides barrel storage underground.

The majority of our bottles are filled with rich red wine. They include **Cabernet Sauvignon**, **Merlot**, **Syrah**, **Petite Sirah** (one of only three produced in Washington) and **Cabernet Port**. We also make a sweet, December-harvested **Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc**.

Masset Winery is a true family affair. Greg makes the wine, while Michaela creates the label artwork and is the smiling face you'll find behind the tasting bar! We offer complimentary tasting, RV and bus parking.
