The "family" consists of Jay and Linda Spurlock, their daughter Nikki and her husband Severino Samaniego. Our dream of opening a winery began in 2004. With lengthy discussions and getting the rest of the family equally motivated, we took the plunge. In 2006 we planted our vineyard. A total of fourteen acres of Viognier, Riesling, Merlot, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon as the chosen varietal's.

With the purchase of local grapes, we had our first bottling of 2004 Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. And we hit the ground running. November of 2006 found us renovating our tasting room. Located at 1717 1st Avenue (just off of exit 54 of I-82 and closer to the city limits of Zillah) you will find our charming, turn of the century renovated farmhouse. After a long seven months of renovating the tasting room was opened in August of 2007.

We have plans to grow in the number of cases produced as well as the varieties we offer, keeping total case production around 3,000. Our goal is to offer exceptional wines, provide friendly and helpful service and to have a place where you will feel welcome, relaxed, have a great wine tasting experience and to be a destination you will want to return to.
